Dear Parents:

Harrison Community Schools will operate a summer school program for students who are deficit credit and working for their high school diploma or students who need remedial help for advancement. The summer school classes will run for twenty-five days during June and July. There is a calendar on the attached sheet. This is a very valuable opportunity for students who have fallen behind in credits to make an effort to catch up to their peers and to graduate on time. Please consider taking advantage of this opportunity.

The program will begin Wednesday, June 10, 2009, and will run until Wednesday, July 22, 2009. Classes will be offered in English and/or math, depending upon staffing and enrollment. Any high school student who needs to make up credit(s) will be allowed to enroll. The intent of the program is to give students an avenue to make up lost credit or to gain skills to pass the MME High School Test.

Cost for the five week program for out of district students will be \$125.00 per class. **Free breakfast and lunch is available for all students.** If there are more registrations than available slots, Harrison students will be given priority placements. DISCIPLINE REGULATIONS FOR STUDENTS

1. Smoking is not allowed on school grounds at anytime.
1st offense - Suspension for one day.
2nd offense - Dismissal from program.
2. Two (2) absences (excused or unexcused) are permitted per class.
Parents need to call the school after 7:30 a.m. if a student will be absent. 539-7417.
All absences count toward the 2 absence limit.
3. Skipping out of class.
1st offense - Warning
2nd offense - Dismissal from program or class.
4. Being tardy for class.
1st offense - Warning
2nd offense - Lunch detention
3rd offense - Counts as one absence and lunch detention
4th offense - Counts as one absence and lunch detention
5th offense - Dismissal from the program or class.
5. No radios, video games, I pods, cell phones, etc. are allowed in class.
6. Students can only be in designated areas of the school.
1st offense - Warning
2nd offense - Suspension for one day
3rd offense - Dismissal from program
7. Any vandalism will be punished with dismissal from the program and restitution has to be made for damages.
8. Aggressive behavior will not be tolerated and fighting will result in dismissal from the program.
9. Grades will not be issued until student's obligations are complete (fees, books returned, etc.)
10. Harrison Community Schools tries to keep their properties clean. Littering can result in dismissal from the program.
11. The use, or being under the influence of, possession or delivery of drugs, look-alikes, and/or alcohol will result in immediate dismissal from the program. When warranted, the matter will be turned over to the Sheriff's Department.
12. All other Harrison High School handbook rules will be enforced.

Note: **Free breakfast and lunch is available for all students.** Any students who are enrolled in both a morning and an afternoon class will have exactly 30 minutes for lunch. Students who bring a lunch must eat in designated areas. They will be allowed to leave for lunch, but will be marked tardy if they are not back in class by 11:30. Reckless driving to and from school will also result in disciplinary action and possible dismissal from the program.
