<p><u>Severe Physical Contact Intimidation Harassment</u> Punching, slapping, kicking, fighting, spitting, threats of emotional or physical violence, racial/ethnic/sexual/religious or other forms of severe harassment or intimidation (includes gossip of a more serious nature), blatant insubordination toward an adult, gang activity, arson, assault, assault on an employee, weapons</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Immediate referral to office • Written report to office • Student calls parent • Minimum 3 day suspension • Possible police report filed • Mandatory parent conference with administrator • Legal action taken 	Referred to office of Superintendent for behavioral interventions
