Are You Tardy?!

HMS has established a whole new schoolwide tardy policy. If you happen to be late to class, the teacher will be likely to have the doors shut and locked. You will have to walk to the office without making a fuss over it and obtain a pass. This unique regulation will support you by returning to the office and telling them the reason you were late. It will be written down by a teacher, if a group of others have the same problem they will try to clarify this dilemma so it's not a recurring problem in the future. However, if you get three tardies you will be given a printed sheet with the dates you were late to your classes with the day and time your detention will be held which, will be lunch in the office. The school enforced this policy because countless students as a whole had acquired at least over 1,000 tardies. If a student receives 3 tardies it will result in one lunch detention held in the office or discipline by administration, but don't worry 3 tardies is basically just a warning. This means that it takes a team of staff to implement policies even though, there is an overseer. 6 tardies will result in one after school detention held in Mrs. Singletons room 410 starting right after school ending at 4:03. During after school detention you will need a book and any incomplete homework assigned to you. If after school detention is missed it will result in 2 lunch detentions, and counted as an additional write up, 9 tardies will result in one day in-school suspension in room 302 with Mr. Benoit starting at the beginning of the day. During In School Suspension (ISS) you will receive work and in school homework assigned by your teacher for each class and make sure to bring a book so you're still being productive after you're done. 12 tardies will result in a Saturday detention. Yet if 3 detentions transpire a parent meeting will be scheduled so, try your best not to be tardy to your classes.
